

VACATION CARE - PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!!!!

Please find attached the documentation for the Sept/Oct 2020 school holiday program at Mildura South.

To make a booking, please complete and return the booking form as soon as possible, either by email or in person.

Unfortunately, we are unable to attend outings these holidays.

Once your booking has been confirmed by the OSHC office, the fees will be added to your account. You will receive a confirmation email with the fee cost and due dates (due dates as below):

Week 1: fees due by Friday 18th Sept 2020 / **Week 2:** fees due by Friday 25th Sept 2020

All children are to bring their own food each day – a packed lunchbox with morning snack, lunch, afternoon snack as well as their own drink bottle each day. Ensure enough food is packed for the entire day!

HATS ARE TO BE WORN FOR ALL OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES. PLEASE PACK A SPARE HAT IN YOUR CHILDS BAG.

Please be aware that we have children with food allergies at the program (Peanuts, cashews, pistachios, walnuts, eggs, kiwi fruit and strawberries). If your child has any of these on any day, please advise staff upon arrival so we can monitor this. We do not allow children to share food at the program.

We have access to the kitchen to heat up lunches if your child/children would like to bring in their own pies/sausage rolls/two minute noodles etc. If children are doing this, they are to hand their lunch to staff upon arrival to enable the staff to keep them stored then cooked/heated up for lunch. We cannot heat up any food for morning or afternoon snack.

If your child requires medication on any day, please complete a medication form with either myself or Kylie upon arrival with dosage details. Medication is to be **clearly labelled with the child's name** and must be in the **original container**. **We cannot accept medication without it being in the original labelled container!**

We do not encourage children to bring in their own toys to the program. We have a variety of toys and equipment that the children can use throughout the day.

Please also label all items (drink bottles, lunch boxes, hats, clothing etc).

Respectful, considerate behaviour towards each other, including staff is expected at all times.

We are not obliged to have children at our program who refuse to comply with our agreed behaviour policy. Depending on the severity of the behaviour, parents will be contacted and will need to collect their child/children from the program as soon as possible. Bullying, teasing, bad language and the lack of respect towards staff or towards other children will not be tolerated. Parents must be contactable at all times or have a contact that is able to collect the child as soon as possible.

IF YOU WILL NOT BE ATTENDING YOUR BOOKED DAY/S, PLEASE CONTACT THE OSHC OFFICE ASAP TO ENABLE A CHILD ON THE WAITING LIST THE OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND. IF WE CANNOT FILL YOUR VACANT SPOT, YOU ARE STILL CHARGED AT THE USUAL RATE.

BOOKING FORM – Vacation Care: Monday 21st Sept to Friday 2nd Oct 2020. To make a booking, please tick the days you require on this form and either return this form to the Outside School Hours office or email the information to oshp@msps.vic.edu.au Bookings will be taken until all places are filled with a waiting list if necessary. Once your booking has been confirmed by the OSHC office, fees will be added to your account. **If you cancel a booked day, you are still charged unless we can fill that vacancy with another child on the waiting list.** Any outstanding OSHC fees are to be paid in full before bookings can be accepted. The full fee is \$60 per day per child. Child Care Subsidy can be used to reduce the fee. An invoice for fees will be sent via email at least one week prior to the due date. Payments can be made over the phone with Credit Card or in person with cash or Eftpos.

**PLEASE NOTE ACCORDING TO AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES:
THERE ARE TWO LEVELS OF PRIORITY WHICH WE MUST FOLLOW.**

Priority 1. – A Child at risk of serious abuse or neglect receiving Additional Child Care Subsidy.

Priority 2. – A child of a single parent who satisfies, or parents who both satisfy the activity test through paid employment
