

VACATION CARE - PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!!!!

Please find attached the documentation for the January 2022 school holiday program at Mildura South.

To make a booking, please complete and return the booking form as soon as possible. Please sign and return the excursion notes if you are booking in for the excursions. **There is also a 2022 OSHC enrolment form to be completed and returned when making your booking.**

You will receive a confirmation email once your booking has been confirmed, fees will then be added to your account. Because the holidays are four weeks long, the due dates for fee payments have been split into four weeks. The first week of care is due by Friday 17th December 2021. Week 2 due 7/1/22. Week 3 due 14/1/22, Week 4 due 21/1/22. Alternatively, you may start paying off the fees once you receive your confirmation if that is easier for you. However, if payment has not been made by these dates, your booking will be cancelled.

IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ATTENDING ON ANY BOOKED DAY, PLEASE CONTACT THE OSHC OFFICE ASAP TO ENABLE A CHILD ON THE WAITING LIST THE OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND. IF WE CANNOT FILL YOUR VACANT SPOT, YOU ARE STILL CHARGED AT THE USUAL RATE.

All children are to bring their own food each day – a packed lunchbox with morning snack, lunch, afternoon snack as well as their own bottle each day. Ensure enough food is packed for the entire day!

HATS are to be worn during outside play. Please pack a hat in your child's bag, hats can be left at the service if that is easier.

Please be aware that we have children with food allergies at the program (Peanuts, cashews, pistachios, walnuts). If your child has any of these on any day, please advise staff upon arrival so we can monitor this. We do not allow children to share food at the program.

We have access to the kitchen to heat up lunches if your child/children would like to bring in their own hot food (pies/sausage rolls/two minute noodles etc). If children are doing this, they are to hand them to staff upon arrival to enable the staff to keep them stored then cooked/heated up for lunch. Please do not bring hot food for lunch on the excursion and incursion days as we do not have time to heat them up on these days.

If your child requires medication on any day, please complete a medication form with either myself or Kylie upon arrival with dosage details. Medication is to be **clearly labelled with the child's name** and must be in the **original container/packet**.

We do not encourage children to bring in their own toys to the program. We have a variety of toys and equipment that the children can use throughout the day.

Please also label all items (drink bottles, lunch boxes, hats, clothing etc).

Respectful, considerate behaviour towards each other and staff is expected at all times.

Our service is not obliged to have children who are disrespectful towards staff and children. Depending on the severity of the behaviour, parents will be contacted and will need to collect their child/children from the program as soon as possible. Bullying, teasing, bad language and the lack of respect towards staff or towards other children will not be tolerated. Parents must be contactable at all times or have a contact that is able to collect the child as soon as possible.

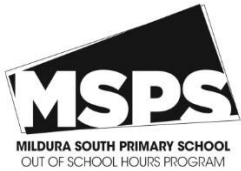

Once your booking has been confirmed by the OSHC office, fees will be added to your account. **If you cancel a booked day, you are still charged unless we can fill that vacancy with another child on the waiting list.** Any outstanding OSHC fees are to be paid in full before bookings can be accepted. The full fee for Vacation Care is \$65 per day per child. Statement of fees will be sent via email at least one week prior to the due date. Payments can be made over the phone with Credit Card or in person with cash or Eftpos. If we have your credit card on file, fees will be deducted from your nominated card on the due dates.
